THE COURSE

The programme follows the 4th or 5th semester syllabus from TEC. You'll study all the subjects you would study in Mexico, but in English, with our teachers in Cambridge. The 5th semester course also offers you the opportunity to join one of our elective topics which are designed to help students prepare for undergraduate level studies at UK universities. Additionally, students will also take the Pearson Exam.

ACCOMMODATION

You will be staying in carefully selected homestay accommodation. Every effort is made to place you in accommodation that suits your needs. Your hosts will provide you with a comfortable bedroom, breakfast, dinner and laundry service. Homestays are located in and around the city centre with easy access to the college. Typically homestays are from 3 to 5km from the college. We'll provide you a bus pass for your first week to help you settle in.
